# HELP STALK VICTIMS RALLY

Dozens of ordinary women are maimed and killed by stalkers in Australia each year as they were unable to call police when attacked or police arrived too late to help them.

Governments refuse to guard ordinary victims, who cannot afford to hire a guard and are not allowed to own or use a practical defensive weapon to guard themselves.

We want the state government to pay for guards to protect vulnerable victims until they can obtain a non-occupational security guard licence and associated security equipment.

One of the best ways to ensure this occurs is to let the state government know that failing to act will cost it votes, which can be done by attending our rally and writing to your MP.

Most of the people terrorized by stalkers are ordinary women just like our mothers, sisters and daughters, people who need our help and are deserving of our love and assistance.

Some will suffer terrible injuries or die unless we can join together to ensure they obtain the protection they and their children need. Please help us help them.
